

TEACHING ABOUT VALUES

Throughout each unit, students will work in teams to prepare and participate in an event at their school.

This task provides students with a unique opportunity to learn about the qualities of an effective team and how they can work together to achieve a common goal.

VALUES ADDRESSED IN THIS UNIT

The values addressed in this unit are:

- respect for others and yourself
- teamwork and how to contribute positively to a team
- fair play and the importance of including others and giving everyone the opportunity to participate.

OPTIONAL VALUES LESSON TO SET THE SCENE

To set the scene, teachers have the option to conduct a lesson on values, provided with this unit.

The lesson is designed to give students an understanding and appreciation of the behaviours that help create an effective team. The lesson also comes with a video of professional footballers reflecting on the value of respect in their lives.

At the end of the lesson student groups will formulate a set of value-based rules that they will commit to throughout the unit.

These rules are designed to provide students and the teacher with a valid point of reference in which to compare student behaviour and attitude.
